Current address or sleeping arrangements (last night and during past week)?
If sleeping rough, where do they sleep (so the Outreach Team workers can find them)?

Current support

Social worker?
CPN?
Tenant of the Council, Housing Association, or other?

For The Hub to help, the client must:

have a housing problem
be 16 years or older
have no dependent children
not be pregnant
