

# **‘Supporting the Homeless’ Sleep Out Pip ‘n’ Jay, Bristol 2 March 2012 Organisation Invitation Letter**

Dear friend,

Following the successful 2011 Sleep Out, I am writing to invite your organisation to join in the 2012 ‘Supporting the Homeless’ Sleep Out to raise awareness of the issues of homelessness in and around Bristol, and to raise, through sponsorship, funds for work with homeless people.

If your organisation works to help homeless people, you are invited to participate and raise funds for your own work. Otherwise, we ask you to nominate the organisation (or organisations) you wish to support.

The idea is that people will sleep out in the grounds of Pip ‘n’ Jay Church, arriving between 10 and 10:30 pm on Friday 4, and leaving between 6:30 and 7 am on Saturday 5. Soup and a bread roll will be provided from 10.30 before people settle for the night, and coffee and a roll from 6 am before people leave. Kitchen facilities are available for the caterers to prepare the soup and drinks, and toilet facilities will be made available throughout the night.

We are asking for organisations to make a small donation of £15 to cover costs (primarily the catering). Each organisation will register its own participants and collect its own sponsorship.
